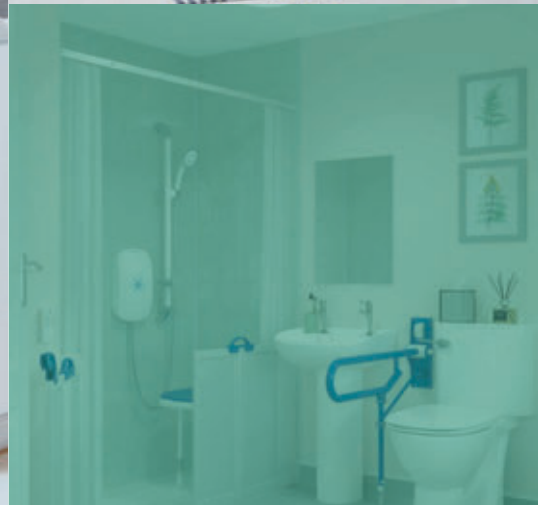

When he was finally operated on, it left him paralysed from the waist down. As a result of this, we started out on a journey of facilitating his care.... It hasn't stopped! The journey from the start up until now has not been straight forward as many people reading this would appreciate. What it has taught me in this time, is that what ever we do we must look ahead, so that whatever solution we come up with is not just a solution for now but for the long term because conditions can change.

So my overriding summary really is 'future proofing'. At the outset we were all trying to understand what needed to be done to facilitate my fathers care, mainly concentrating on his condition as it was then. This really resulted in decisions being made that were very short term. What we failed to do was look forward into the future and how his condition may change and what his needs may be going forward. This is, understandably very hard to do.

As a paraplegic, my fathers needs changed as time went on. This is something I have found in common with many less abled or disabled individuals so a good understanding

from our perspective at the outset is extremely important to ensure we can come up with a solution that will be long term rather than having to go through the process again. I feel it is my mission in life to help simplify this for you where possible. It often means working closely with health care specialists such as occupational therapists and case managers etc.

This has driven me to make a difference to the lives of great people that have mobility issues, and ensure they can enjoy the comforts of their own home as best as they possibly can. My mother (who is the primary carer for my father) was adamant that she wanted the right facilities to enable my father to enjoy his own home. Thus far she has succeeded this, and this is the mission I have for all those I am in contact with.

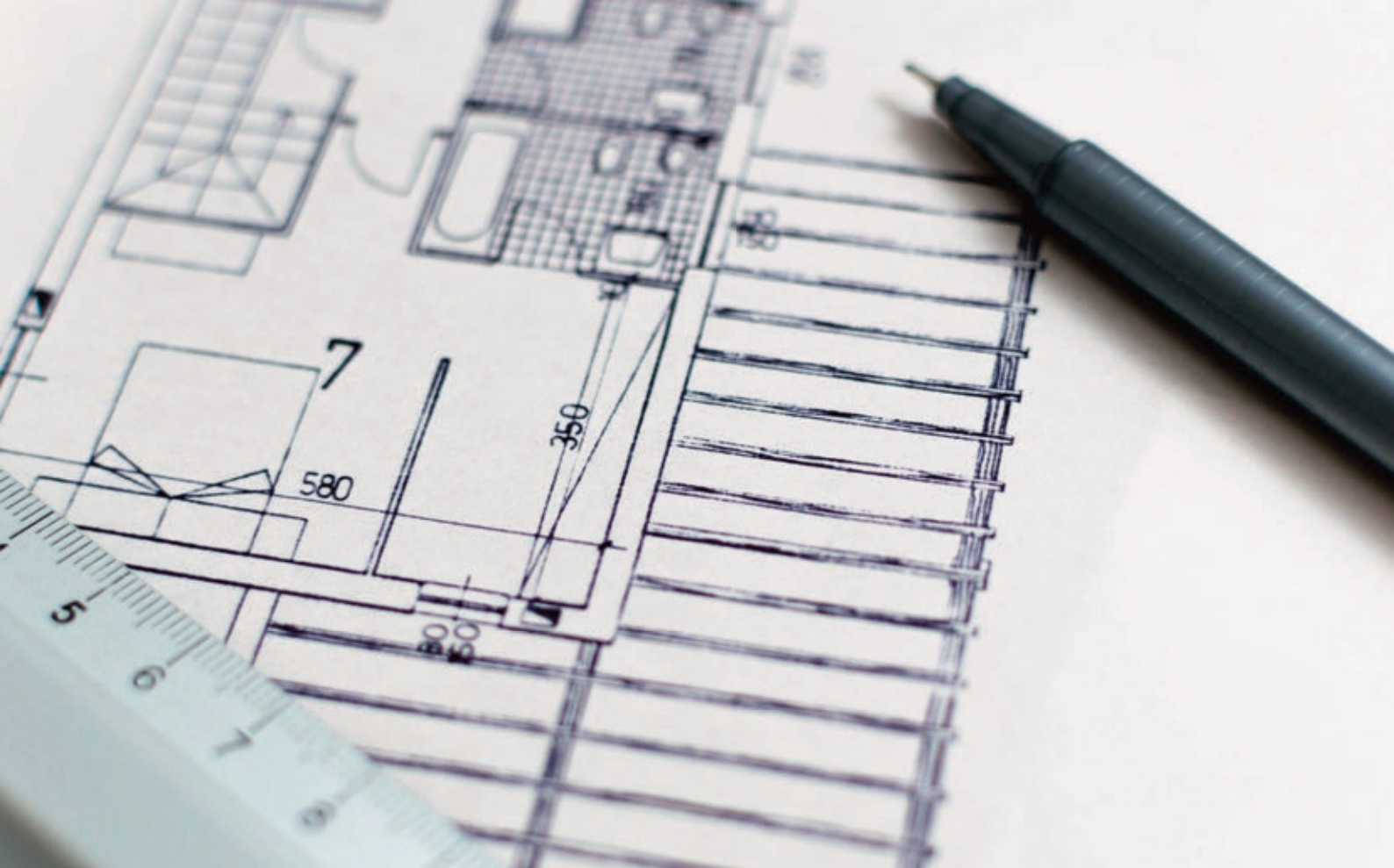

Walk-in Showers

Providing a safe and comfortable bathing experience.



A walk-in shower is designed specifically with the elderly and less mobile in mind. The main difference between a walk-in shower and a conventional shower is not having to climb over the side of a bath in a shower/bath combination or up into a shower with a large step up.

For those with mobility needs, the act of bathing can be difficult and often unsafe. With a specially adapted accessible walk-in shower, these can reduce the risk of slips, trips, and falls, and provide a safe and comfortable bathing experience for users and carers alike. The individual needs of each client are at the forefront of how we go about finding suitable accessible showering solutions.

People choose a walk-in shower because of several different reasons; walk-in showers should be considered if any of the following are experienced:





Reasons to have a walk-in shower

- Find the bath or existing shower difficult to get in and out of
- Bathing is becoming unsafe and uncomfortable
- Want a solution that causes minimal disruption
- Desire a bathing solution that is bespoke to your bathroom

Low-Level Access Showers

Our Low-Level Showering options provide a perfect solution for ambulant users who have difficulty getting in and out of the bath but can manage a small step. This type of installation is also great if you are just wanting to replace a bath with a shower for example, without re-doing the whole bathroom.

The Low-Level solution will give a small step of 40mm or slightly less, so would not be suitable for wheelchair users that require a wheelchair whilst showering.

Level Access Showers:

A Level Access shower is an invaluable solution that will make your showering room that much more accessible.



Level Access shower trays are set flush into your bathroom floor and have no height difference between the tray edge and the floor allowing unrestricted access to the shower.

Suited perfectly for wheelchair users which allows for entry and exit of the shower unassisted. Like our wetroom solutions, accessories can be installed to suit your needs.

Case Study

Mrs C - Essex

Mrs C. was an elderly client whose mobility was gradually declining due to arthritis. The existing space was becoming very challenging and restrictive for her with the small showering cubicle. Another challenge for Mrs C was the upkeep of her bathroom with moving parts on the shower cubicle and tile grout joints to maintain and keep clean.



The Aim

To provide an accessible, easy to maintain solution for Mrs C's challenges within the bathroom with minimal disruption to her home.

Our Solution

We were able to come up with a solution that would make her bathroom less challenging and restrictive by installing a larger low-level access shower spanning across the right side of the bathroom. As well, we installed a fixed shower screen and shower panels to make it as easy to maintain as possible for Mrs C.

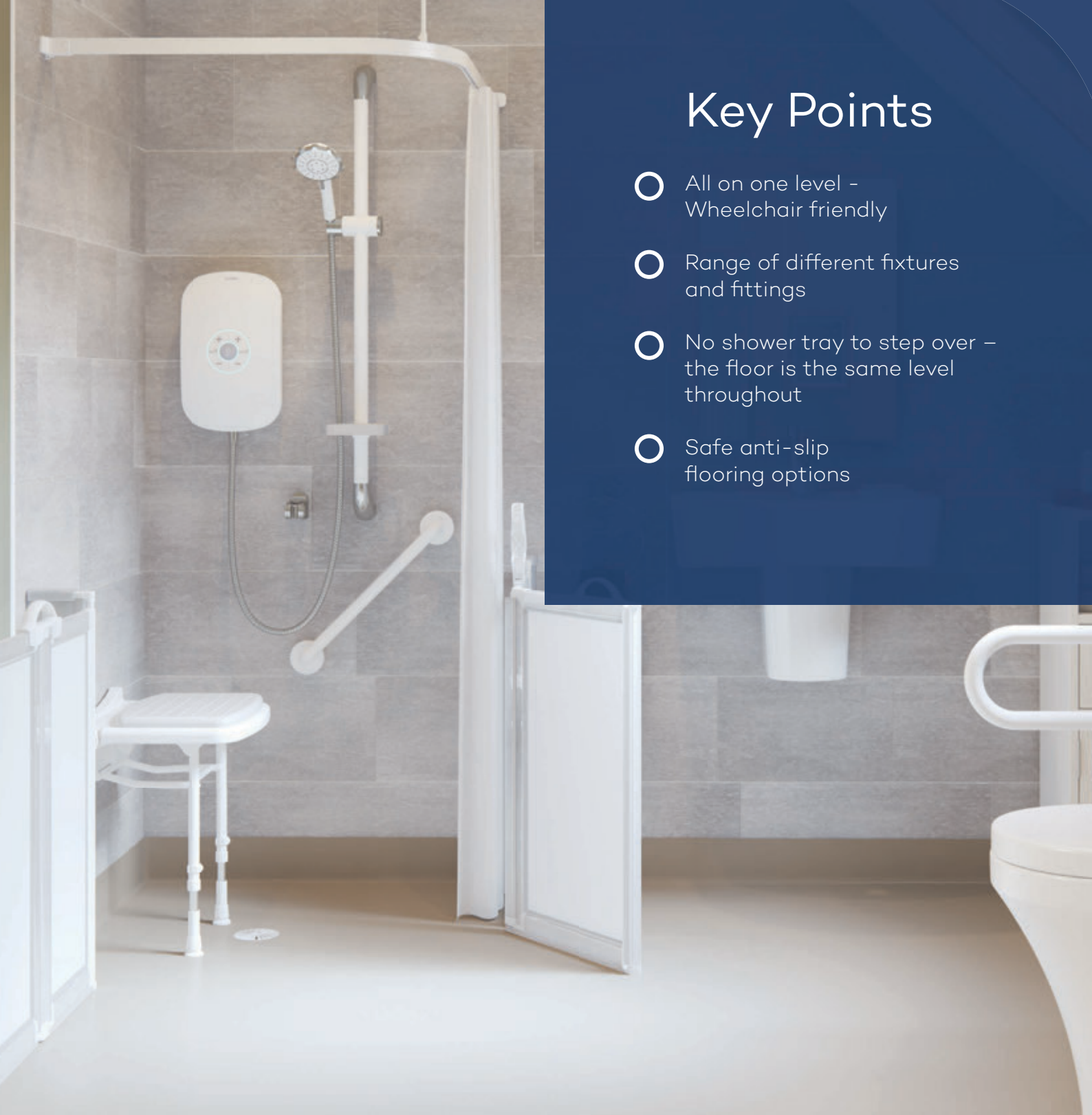

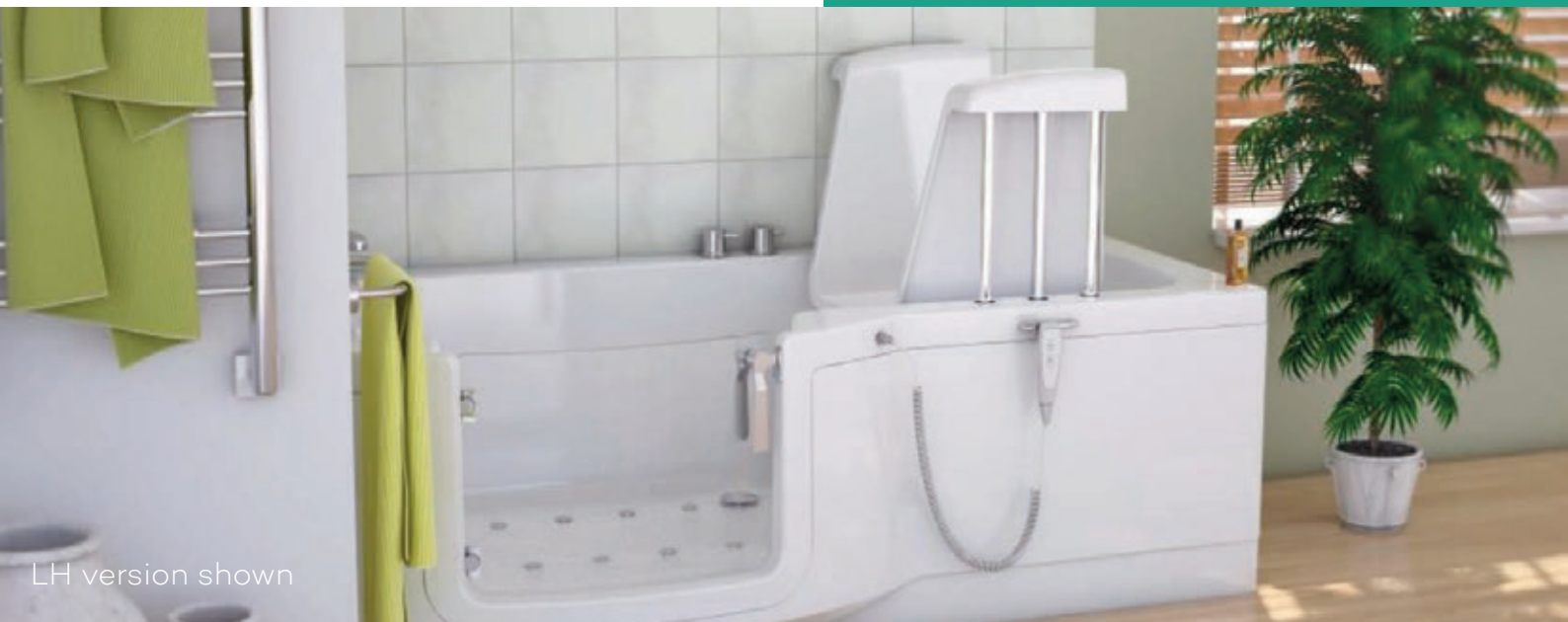

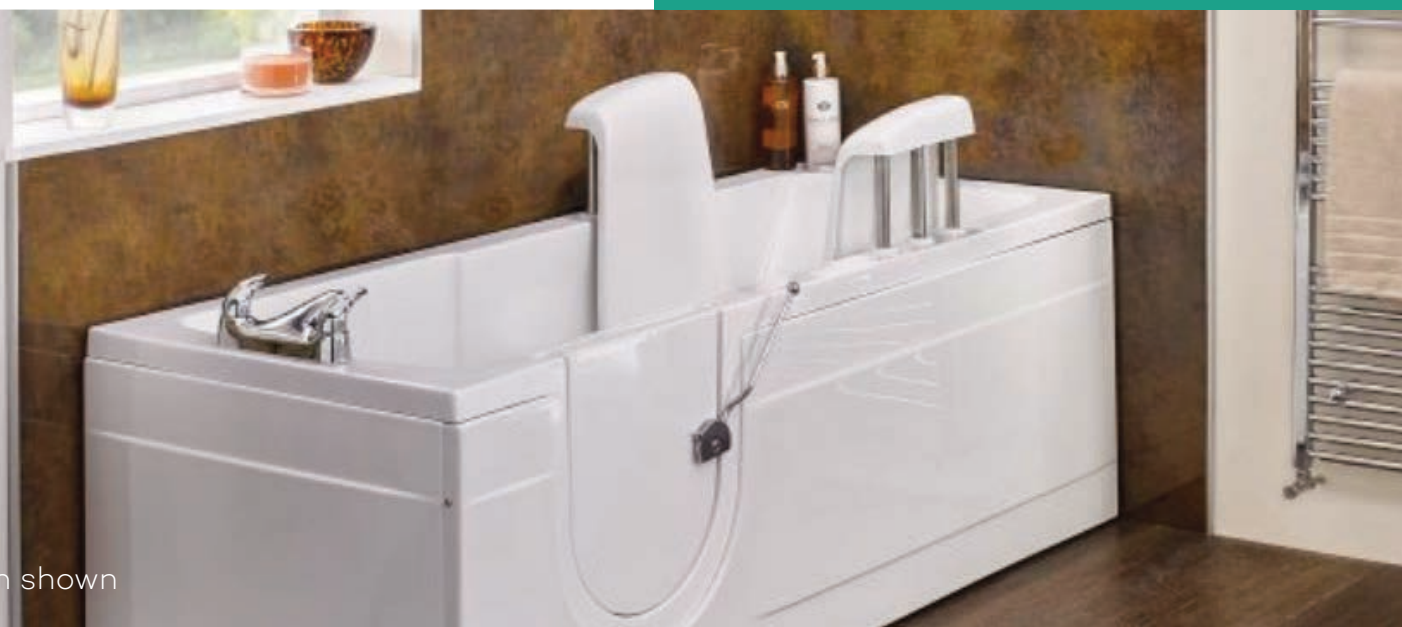

Case Study

Mrs D - Cornwall

Mrs D had recently had a knee operation which meant that lifting her leg over the side of the bath was a struggle and getting up after having a bath even more so. Mrs D really enjoys having a bath and didn't want her mobility challenges to affect her daily routines and pleasures.



The Aim

To provide Mrs D with a bathing solution that meant the strain on her knees was minimised and pleasures maintained.

Our Solution

We were able to come up with the ideal solution that included the Stowbridge bath being installed in place of the old bath whilst still leaving existing tiles. The Stowbridge was felt to be the right solution as it included a low level access entry through the door and a lift that would assist Mrs D stand up once her bath was complete.



The treatment from assessment, to project management, right through to sign off was excellent.

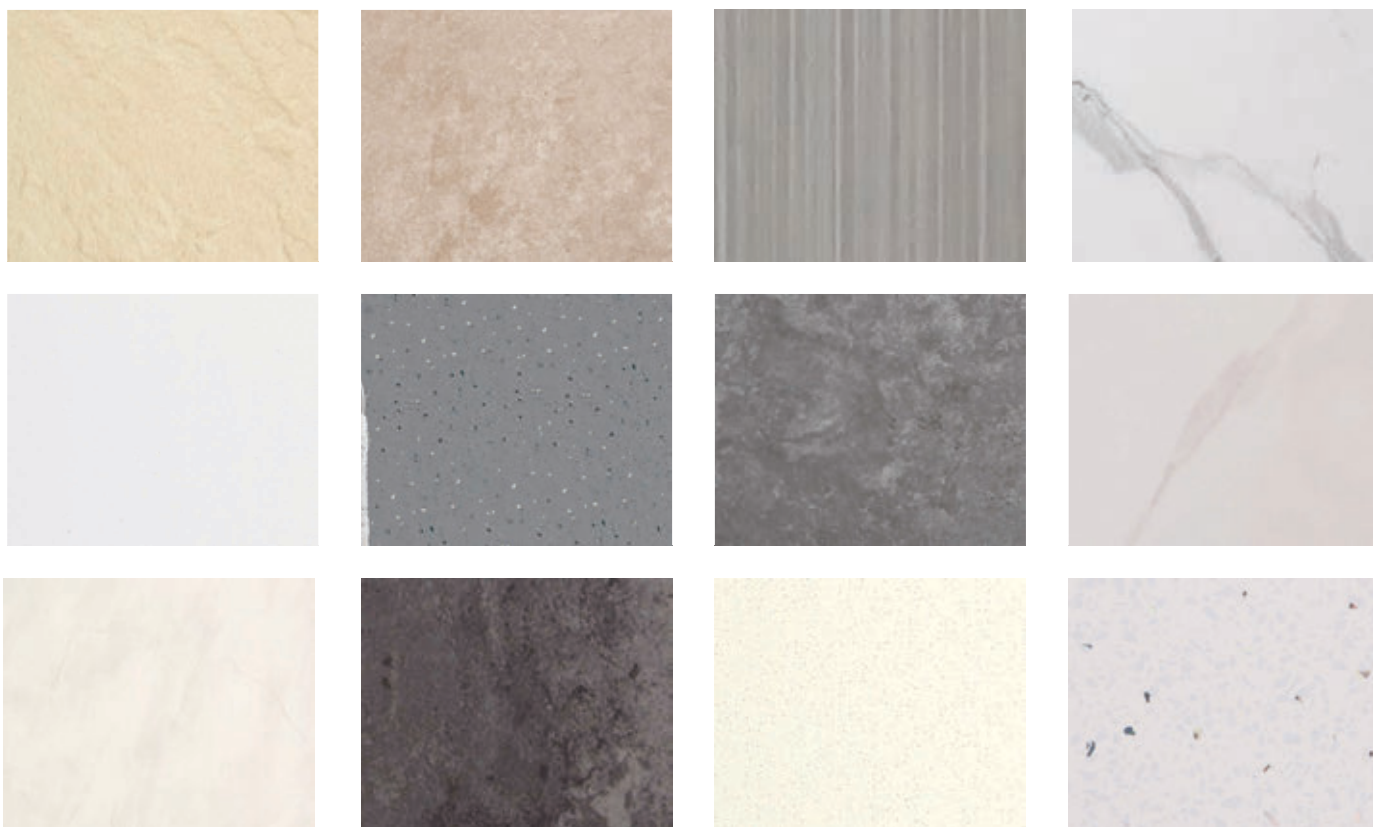

The smart toilet combines a toilet, bidet and drier in one unit. These are an essential item to keep personal hygiene maintained when upper body mobility issues are present. Our smart toilet is designed to put you in control. Its innovative features include a hybrid hot water system with a continuous flow heater and a water storage heater that guarantees warm water even if the wash is run one after another.

The one minute wash cycle draws from the warmed tank of water and the continuous flow heater on the first use, this can be followed by another minute of wash with warm water directly from the continuous flow heater, whilst the water storage tank refills. Thanks to this technology you'll always have a warm water wash and the confidence to feel clean. Warm air drying will leave you clean and fresh, along with a single activation control panel for ease of use. Everything is designed with your comfort and convenience in mind.

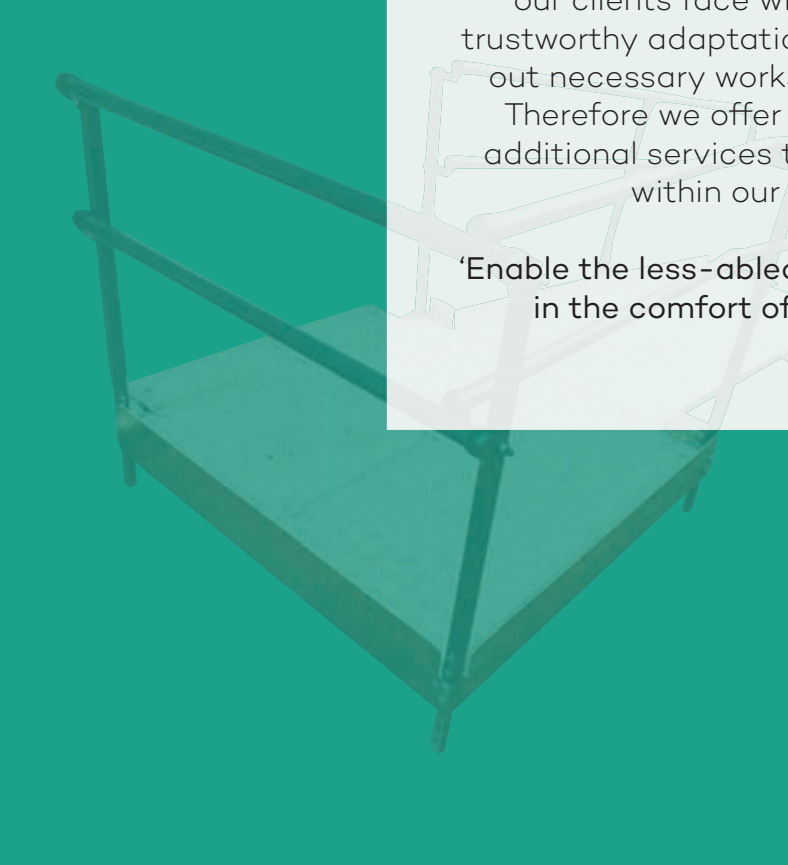

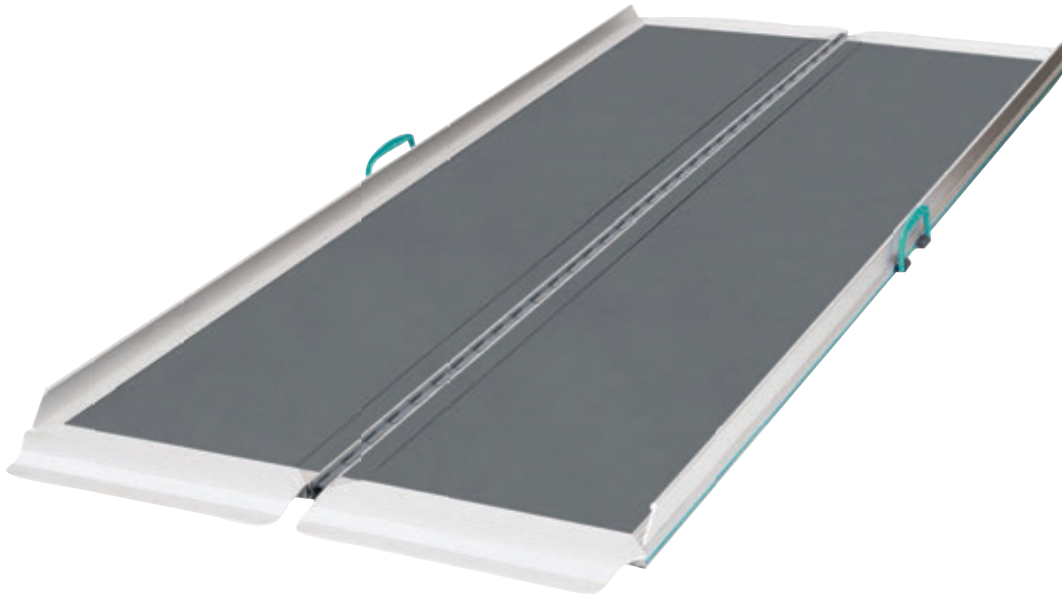

Case Study

Mrs F - Yorkshire

We were contacted by Mrs F daughter after her mother had experienced several falls trying to get outside from her back door, an 8-inch step. One of her health visitors recommended that they should look to get a ramp solution fitted in order to improve Mrs F's independence and ensure she can safely get outside to enjoy her garden (...and her tortoises!).



The Aim

To enable Mrs F to regain her independence by providing a safe access solution to her back door.

Based on Mrs F's needs, we installed a level access platform that was flush with the door threshold attaching to a 12 to 1 ratio ramp. This accompanied with a dual handhold rail. 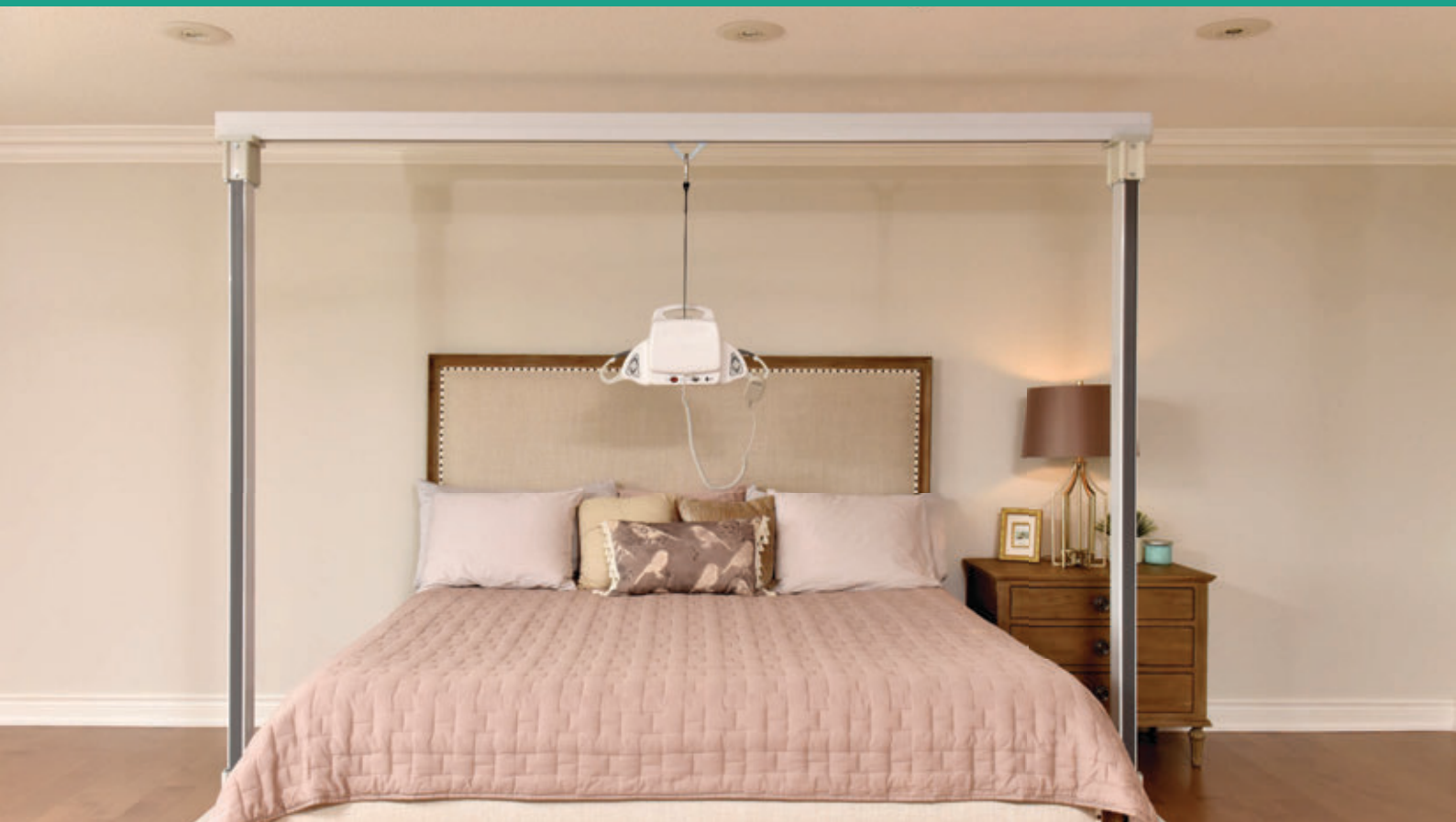
Ceiling Track



Ceiling track hoists ensure a safe, quick way of transfer. They run along permanently fixed tracks so they do not occupy floor space as a mobile hoist does. They also may be operated by the user independently which isn't possible with any floor standing system. These are designed and installed by our very own team of equipment specialists.

Mobile



Mobile hoists are the most common type of hoists and can be used in different situations and potentially every room in the house and even in and out of the car. Being self-contained units, mobile hoists don't require any track installation, offering flexibility of use. These are easily transportable and can be moved from room to room if required.

Funding Options

There are several funding options available to help towards the cost of essential home adaptations to your home such as wetroom facilities, access equipment and minor adaptations. All of these may be subject to means testing.

Government bodies, charitable organisations and benevolent funds are the main providers of these grants. The most common one is the local councils Disabled Facilities Grant (DFG).

What is the Governments Disabled Facilities Grant?

These are grants available to help people with disabilities to remain in the comfort of their own homes by providing support towards adaptations and specialist facilities.

You will qualify for grant aid if you are either registered or registrable as disabled. If you think you may be, then you should contact your local council and they will arrange an assessment by an Occupational Therapist. The process from assessment to work complete can be very variable depending on budgetary constraints and the work load of your local council.

Grants are often means-tested which involves providing details of your financial situation and these figures will indicate whether you are eligible for a grant or calculate whether you must contribute towards the work.

What is a benevolent fund?

A benevolent fund is an institution, including a body of trustees, which holds funds on trust for the purpose of relieving poverty amongst a defined group of individuals. The nexus between that group of individuals could be a common employer, or a common trade or profession, or membership of a particular members club. There are approximately 3,000 benevolent funds currently operating in the UK, of which the vast majority are registered charities.

Some of these include the RAFBF (Royal Air Force Benevolent Fund), West Midlands Police Benevolent Fund and The National Benevolent Charity.
